The Bronte has been the only youth and community centre in Liverpool City Centre for over 50 years, providing essential services for children and communities from all areas of Merseyside.

Since inception, our unique centre, based just metres away from Lime Street Station, has raised over an incredible £4million for young people across Liverpool. But now we need your help.



After changing the lives of thousands of people, our Bronte Big Build campaign is aiming to raise £750,000 to keep our doors open. Without this, we face the immediate threat of closure.

We are seeking partnerships, collaborations and donations to fund the final phase of our Big Build campaign, transforming our facilities and creating new memories, experiences and positive outcomes for thousands of disadvantaged young people.

Our campaign has been backed by Liverpool football legends Jamie Carragher and Robbie Fowler, boxing superstar Tony Bellew and our patron DJ, Lee Butler. We have received major media coverage from BBC News, Liverpool ECHO and many more.

As well as a complete remodel of our first-floor space for additional community benefits, the Big Build will create a flexible space for office rental, allowing The Bronte to generate our own income and become fully self-sustained.

We are also installing a commercial kitchen and cafe, capable of providing professional catering services for over 100 guests, as well as solar panels, reducing operational costs and supporting the long-term sustainability of our much-loved building.

What was once at risk of becoming another derelict plot, is now set to become a fully-functioning centre serving the entire Merseyside region, providing we can secure the remaining funds.
